Compared to our last sale: Feeder calves and yearlings sold mostly steady to strong. Packer cows sold steady to \$ 1.00 lower.

Stocker-feeder steers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs., 130.00-155.00

300-400 lbs., 115.00-132.50; 400-500 lbs., 100.00-115.00; 500-600 lbs., 90.00-100.00; 600-700 lbs., 78.00-92.00. The bull calves and the number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Stocker-feeder heifers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs., 110.00-127.50; 300-400 lbs., 97.00-115.00; 400-500 lbs., 90.00-100.00; 500-600 lbs., 85.00-93.00; The number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality heifer calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Packer cows: Good lean utility and commercial, 44.00-47.50; Cutters, 39.00-45.00; Canners, 32.50-37.00; Low yielding fat cows, 35.00-38.00. Smooth fat cows for the Mexico trade \$ 45.00 to \$49.00.

Packer bulls: Yield grade 1 & 2, good heavy bulls; 54.00-57.00; light weights and medium quality bulls 48.00-52.00; bull yearlings 68.00-75.00.

Dry stock cows: 45.00 to 55.00
