Receipts this week: 978 Cattle

Compared to our last sale: Feeder calves and yearlings sold \$2.00 and \$4.00 higher.

Packer cows sold steady to \$1.00 higher.

Stocker-feeder steers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs. 117.00 ◆ 145.00; 300-400 lbs., 105.00 ◆ 135.00; 400-500 lbs., 95.00-115.00; 500-600 lbs., 87.00-100.00; 600-700 lbs., 78.00-87.00. The bull calves and the number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Stocker-feeder heifers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs., 100.00-125.00; 300-400 lbs., 90.00-110.00; 400-500 lbs., 88.00-105.00; 500-600 lbs., 80.00-87.00. The number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality heifer calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Packer cows: Good lean utility and commercial, 36.00-44.00; Cutters, 34.00-38.00; Canners, 30.00-34.00; Low yielding fat cows, 34.00-38.00.

Packer bulls: Yield grade 1 & 2, good heavy bulls; 48.00-52.00; light weights and medium quality bulls 43.00-48.00; bull yearlings 62.00-68.00.

Dry stock cows: 45.00 to 55.00
