

MARKET REPORT  **Saturday, June 15, 2002**

Receipts this week: 1190 cattle

Compared to our last sale: Feeder calves and yearlings sold \$3.00 higher.

Packer cows sold fully steady.

Stocker-feeder steers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs. 100.00-125.00; 300-400 lbs., 82.00-100.00, 400-500 lbs., 80.00-95.00; 500-600 lbs., 70.00-83.00; 600-700 lbs., 62.00-75.00. The bull calves and the number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Stocker-feeder heifers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs., 85.00-105.00-300-400 lbs., 75.00-90.00; 400-500 lbs., 72.00-82.00; 500-600 lbs., 67.00-78.00. The number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality heifer calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Packer cows: Good lean utility and commercial, 37.00-41.00; Cutters, 35.00-40.00; Canners, 33.00-38.00; Low yielding fat cows, 28.00-34.00.

Packer bulls: Yield grade 1 & 2, good heavy bulls; 51.00-55.00; light weights and medium quality bulls 48.00-52.00; bull yearlings 59.00-65.00.

Dry stock cows: 45.00 to 55.00
