Receipts this week: 691 Cattle

Compared to our last sale: Feeder calves and yearlings sold steady to strong.

Packer cows sold fully steady.

Stocker-feeder steers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs. 117.00 ◆ 157.00; 300-400 lbs., 105.00 ◆ 135.00; 400-500 lbs., 92.00-112.50; 500-600 lbs., 83.00-108.00; 600-700 lbs., 78.00-87.00. The bull calves and the number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Stocker-feeder heifers: Medium and large frame No. 1: 150-300 lbs., 100.00-132.50; 300-400 lbs., 95.00-115.00; 400-500 lbs., 85.00-105.00; 500-600 lbs., 79.00-89.00. The number 1-1/2 & number 2 quality heifer calves are discounted from \$3.00 to \$7.00 per hundred.

Packer cows: Good lean utility and commercial, 42.00-48.50; Cutters, 38.00-43.00; Canners, 36.00-42.00; Low yielding fat cows, 36.00-40.00.

Packer bulls: Yield grade 1 & 2, good heavy bulls; 53.00-60.00; light weights and medium quality bulls 50.00-54.00; bull yearlings 62.00-68.00.

Dry stock cows: 45.00 to 55.00
